- **DE/Solo:** For relatively new drivers, passing with point-by only in certain straight sections of track. Stock seat belts OK.
- **Point-By:** For drivers with more experience, passing anywhere on the track with a point-by. Stock seat belts OK for 2000 & newer cars unless engine mods or race tires (see Entry form, page 2 for more details).
- Open Passing: For very experienced drivers & faster cars, passing anywhere on the track with no point-by required. 5 or 6 point harnesses
- · Race Group: Wheel to wheel racing, typical racing equipment required

Lunchtime Intro Group - We also be conducting our lunchtime Intro Group at this event. Never been on the track before? Got a real nice car and you just want to experience driving it on a race course? The Intro Group is perfect for you! You'll get about an hour of classroom time, then 30-45 minutes on the track following an instructor, all for only \$30. You can do it both days for \$50.
